

RELI 104: Introduction to New Testament Literature



The New Testament is the Scripture for over two billion people today and is arguably the most significant book in the history of Western Civilization. Students who take this class will have the opportunity to study it – for many of them, for their one and only chance in an academic setting. In the class we examine the Gospels of the New Testament, as well as several Gospels that are outside of it; we determine what the historical Jesus really said and did; we explore the writings and teachings of Paul; and we learn about the history of the earliest Christian church. There are no prerequisites for the course, other than a desire to learn about a truly important book and the history that lies behind it.
