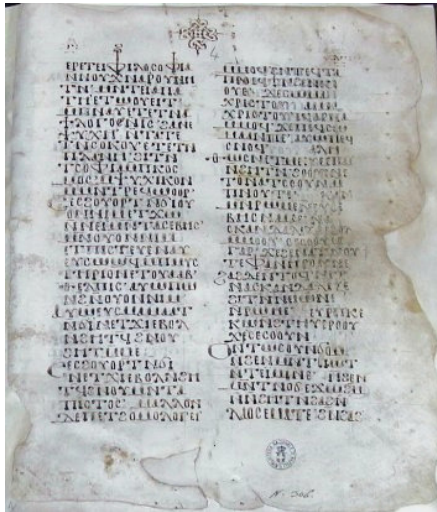


RELI 413: Biblical Coptic and Early Egyptian Monasticism



Introduction to Coptic, the last stage of Egyptian language in the Roman and Byzantine period. The aim of the course is to give students a thorough grounding in grammar and vocabulary of the standard Sahidic dialect as a basis for reading the Gospels of Mark and John, monastic sayings, Gnostic and Manichaean texts, and the literary corpus of the great monastic leader Shenoute of Atripe.
